Many people think heatstroke only occurs in the summer, but in fact, cases of heatstroke often begin to appear as early as May, before the rainy season starts. </p> <p>In May, our bodies are still not used to sweating. When temperatures suddenly rise, our ability to sweat effectively may not keep up, increasing the risk of heatstroke. In some cases, heatstroke can lead to serious symptoms. However, it is a condition that can be prevented with proper care. </p> <p>One of the most important ways to prevent heatstroke is by maintaining a regular and healthy lifestyle. Be sure to get enough sleep and eat three balanced meals a day to keep your body in good condition.</p>
